Some resources e.g. journal papers could not be obtained. For me, it was a significant number.

The civil engineering laboratories are predominantly outdated. The asphalt lab in particular needs funding. is highly qualified to teach and perform research far beyond what his lab can perform. The soils lab needs funding. If you want to hire a halfway decent geotechnical professor (and you need to), than you had better put something more cutting edge than 1980 in the lab.

The library has very helpful faculty and the ability to get any information they don't already have in a timely manner. As for our lab, its more of a do what you can with what you have kind of thing. The larger equipment is WW2 era, and the building itself keeps getting gutted for asbestos problems. It would be nice if better space/equipment was available, but we seem to get by.

The fact that there are tuition waivers for graduate students and the info on how to get it was not readily made known to me. I missed out on an entire semester of this financial aid due to lack of information provided by the graduate college. When I did discover the available aid, it was from another student, and the forms for it were very difficult to find.

Post admission assessment is something strange a little bit. It would be better if all requirements are requested pre admission/arrival to OSU.

Q59. Do you have any final comments about your experience as a graduate student at OSU?

- I think you do a great job gathering information from students to improve the quality of education at OSU. However, I believe some of the questions were too general and there was no easy way to answer them. For instance I may be satisfied by teaching skills of one faculty but not with another one. Or, some faculty may have been very helpful helping me plan for my future career but another one was neutral. Long story short, I think some questions should come with wider answer options. Thank
- I was lucky to have been able to take classes from experienced professors like Snethen, Cross and Gregory. OSU needs more national and internationally accomplished professors to keep the standard OSU used to be known for. The direction the OSU geotechnical department is headed is truly sad.
- I would prefer to receive notice about filling out a Plan of Study earlier in the semester and be given time to fill it out. Rather than receiving an email half way through the semester that states "a hold is put on your enrollment until you fill out a plan of study." Again, I was not informed about this by the graduate college in any way prior to the email. Thus, the hold is an inconvenience for me (a "punishment" dealt out by the graduate college) for something they failed to inform me of.
- It's a good program; I just wish I saw more professors that specialized in some of the various other areas of my field of study. Our department seems to be understaffed as far as for educators and our head says he's looking for more faculty, but I haven't seen anything of it.
- Some professors give assignments on topics that are either unexplained in class or out of the syllabus or both. Others don't adequately evaluate students' efforts throughout the semester by giving low grades; always each semester. The two attitudes highly depress and discourage students. They also highly affect students' academic records and future employment. Many students complain of the two mentioned attitudes. It would be great that anything could be done towards further enhancements.
- The CIVE staff does exceptionally well in both the classroom and in research. However, the department suffers from a great lack of additional staff, forcing graduate students to petition for the majority of the coursework in which they desire to take. Although research has been extremely rewarding, laboratory space is quite rare which confines the amount and quality of ongoing research. The issue is compounded by a lack of up to date equipment.
