Although I am a distance student, I really felt like a person and not just an entity.

- I am surprised the ETM program is not advertised in military education offices. I found the program by web surfing. I struck gold with this one but found that most of the folks that I work with that are in military engineering was unaware of your program.
- I wished OSU offered a professional engineering review course and/or still had courses related to control system engineering as it relates to the International Society of Automation.
- My only complaint is the two classes I took with In her lectures, she reads from a script and barely makes eye contact with the camera. He lectures are numerous and lengthy. This made it extremely painful to the point that I actually stopped watching the lectures and just started reading the lecture notes from the PowerPoint files. I just don't feel like I got the best bang for the buck with her classes and assignments didn't make the best connection to the lecture material.
- Overall the experience has been good. Class schedule has been problematic. The fact that the one hour courses are only scheduled for 5 weeks, means the class requires the same attention as a 3 hour course while it is ongoing. Since I work full time it can be challenging juggling the requirements of both. Having a 1 hour course run all semester would reduce that problem. I travel frequently which means I have less cushion to keep up with classes.
- The only problem I encountered as a student was two faculty members that did not communicate. As an on-line student, when professors do not offer feedback and are late in returning grades or assignments, it makes it almost impossible to assess your progress in class. This happened twice during my courses at OSU, including one professor who did not even post final grades until a month after class ended. (He also did not answer emails). (It was a one hour class).

The teachers need to help the students more.
