### **Summary of Assessment Findings**

Describe overall assessment findings and faculty members' interpretation of the assessment results: In all areas, each objective either met expectations (Proficient) or exceeded expectations (Advanced). The NURS 3025 Assessment and Community Health Nursing, due to student feedback and input from our site evaluators, the decision was made to change the focus from clinical hours to clinical assignments. This will allow a broader view of the community as the client focus. Based on regional norms of Leadership and Management courses in the RN to BSN programs, faculty decided a clinical component would be a positive addition to NURS 4034 Leadership and Management in Nursing. This involves several clinical assessments that address SLO's 3, 5 & 8.

Based on data collected this year, what changes are being considered or planned for the program?: As previously mentioned, the NURS 3025 Assessment and Community Health Nursing course will change the focus from clinical hours to clinical assignments. This will allow a broader view of the community as the client focus.

Also, the addition of a clinical component to NURS 4034 Leadership and Management in Nursing will provide a more thorough opportunity for students to experience the leadership/management role prior to graduation.

Based on this year's findings, what (if any) changes are planned for the assessment process?: The process will remain the same; however, actual assessments will differ.

**Describe the process for implementing these changes/planned program improvements:** The biggest change of adding a clinical component to NURS 4034 involved a Program and Planning change which occured at the school, college, and university level. This approval process for the course change went into effect fall 2019. The other changes occurred at the program level and was vetted through the various committees.

**Program Improvements Made in the Last Year:** Course Improvements, Curriculum Improvements, Assessment Measure Improvements, Revised Assessment Plan, Improved Faculty Understanding or Buy-In, Increased Rigor
