Survey Report – University Studies – College for Education and Human Sciences

The OSU Alumni Survey is a survey designed to collect information about OSU graduated students. More specifically, it is designed to collect information on their career, educational achievements, and their experience with OSU. This information will be used to improve academic programs and student experiences at OSU for generations to come. This survey targeted alumni of undergraduate and graduate programs who received their degree in 2015 and/or 2019. The survey was administered online by OSU-University Assessment and Testing (UAT) in March 2021 through May 2021. Survey Questions

Respondents were asked up to 26 institutional level items. Institutional level items were given to all OSU alumni and the items consisted of six topics: continuing education, well-being and community, demographic information, academic satisfaction, career reflection, and current job or career information.

During times of "racial problems" I wish you all could've been louder about the situation. Yeah we fit in but being black at OSU was kind of like being a sore thumb sometimes. I don't know how you all will fix that but it's probably a underlying feeling most of us feel.

I completed 300 hours of a 400 hour internship before I was informed that it would not count towards my school credit. I didn't have enough time to find a new internship and ended up with a University Studies degree instead of my Health Education degree. So probably communicating expectations beforehand and if the University makes a mistake the student doesn't get punished for it.

I don't have any idea

It's hard to say. There is a lot of opportunities I didn't take advantage of. I do not feel that I made the best of my situation at OSU. I'm grateful for my degree, but I probably got what I put into it - which was minimal effort.

More financial advice/quidance

Non-biased advisors

Not been racist.

Offered more majors 100% online or at Tulsa campus.

Offered special education program online

The Early Childhood Education Program was terrible. I had no support from the professors and the classes were not helpful.

There was a huge discrepancy with my financial aid because the bursar office distributed all the funds without accounting for my tuition and fees. I went the entire semester without knowing until enrolling the next semester. It threw my graduation date off by 5 years. I went back and finished when I could. It was highly disappointing that when discussing this with OSU that ultimately I took all the blame. The only time it's ever happened in my entire collegiate career.

26. What additional information would you like OSU to know?

Go Pokes and keep growing! Every day is better than the day before!

I love that I went to OSU. I truly do. However, the increased racism I've experienced when returning to campus for Homecoming and Game days is extremely disheartening. I believe that OSU could have handled their response to COVID-19 better. I don't believe OSU is as progressive as other universities throughout the nation. I don't believe OSU has the same loyalty to their staff, students, and alumni that we have for it.

It was a great experience, thank you all for your help on my journey!

You should really focus on collaboration and oral/written skills. The future is learning how to work with groups of people to accomplish goals. There is also a dichotomy in working with groups and solo individual effort. You also shouldn't take what I have to say too seriously, either - I did graduate with a very mediocre GPA.
