Q59. Do you have any final comments about your experience as a graduate student at OSU?

I lost my desire to be and do my best because of the hands-off, don't-bother-me attitude of some of the professors.

- My program (school psychology) has not done a good job of making the transition into graduate school easy. I was totally unaware of things like a Plan of Study, which caused me to be delayed in enrolling because I had a hold on my account. The program has not explained what we need to be doing to get registered for classes or what forms we need to submit for the graduate college. Professors are not available for help, and the older students are constantly intimidating. It is not what I imagined.
- Sometimes the faculty takes advantage of graduate students and act unprofessionally and there is nothing we can do about it. These faculty make very big decisions about our grades and dissertations and when they get out of control there is no way to protect you. In order to make a complaint you have to make yourself open to negative action from the faculty member and that isn't fair. We are students, not children; most of us are adults and deserve to be treated with respect.
- There should be checks and balances beyond the internal program faculty that is informed and involved with the operations and quality of the programs. Significant decline in application and placement should be significant indicators that there may be internal issues within a given program. Teacher and class evaluations are not enough to govern and direct small program structure. National body accreditation is not sure sign of internal stability.
