Most of the time when I call the graduate college, people answering the phones are rude and not helpful. I try to do everything that I can through the staff at my College and contact the Graduate College only when I have no other choice.

They do not do a good job of communicating what is needed on a monthly, semester, or yearly basis. There is little guidance or support offered, and students are expected to have everything figured out all by themselves. Every semester there is some mix-up with TA/GA waiver forms, related to getting paid and tuition waivers. Suggestions: Have regular workshops, updates, or communication between grad college and schools/departments on campus.
